



**Call for nominations
for the Jiří Hoskovec Prize
in 2020**

The prize is granted in honour of the significant Czech psychologist Prof. PhDr. Jiří Hoskovec, CSc.

The Prize is awarded for a significant contribution to the development of Czech psychology. This may be represented by a remarkable act in the previous period of time or a lifelong contribution to the respective field. The spheres of the contribution range from scientific, educational, and practical fields to international cooperation.

Nominations

Physical as well as legal entities from the Czech Republic and abroad with a significant relationship to the field of psychology may be nominated. The deadline for submitting nominations is **29th March 2020**. Nominations, together with the corresponding documentation, are to be sent in electronic form to the address cmps@ecn.cz.

Nominations must include the following data:

- Name and surname of the candidate, titles, institutions
- Contact details for the candidate: email, phone, address
- The candidate's CV or possibly a summary of their publication activities (in the case of a legal entity, its vision and history)
- Workplace (in the case of a physical entity)
- Description of the reasons for the awarding of the Prize – results achieved in the candidate's work, public acceptance by the domestic and international community, impact on society, development of scientific knowledge (one A4 document)
- We recommend sending all supporting materials illustrating the candidate's contribution to the development of Czech psychology as an attachment
- Name and contact details for the nominator

In 2020, the Prize will be awarded at the ICP 2020 International Congress of Psychology (19th-24th July 2020) in Prague. The successful candidate shall, apart from the Prize itself, also receive a financial reward amounting to CZK 10,000.
